

Interior Design Extra Credit Activity Sheet

Student can receive up to **twenty extra credit points** for interior design courses by participating in various interior design/art department activities. Common activities are listed below with assigned points. Activities not listed will be announced throughout the semester by interior design faculty and given a point value. Student must have an instructor attending the activity sign below verifying attendance. A maximum of ten points can be applied to each interior design course. This sheet must be submitted to the instructor(s) of interior design course(s) that student wishes to have the extra credit points applied **ONE WEEK** prior to exam date. Interior design instructors will decide how the points are applied.

Student must attend the entire activity time to receive points. Points must be accumulated during one semester and applied to a course of the same semester.

- Student Career Day – 5 points
- Art Department Gallery Reception – 1 point
- ASID Fundraiser – 2 points
- ASID Field Trip – 5 points
- ASID Mentoring Program – 1 point for each meeting
- Habitat for Humanity Community Service – 5 points
- ASID Membership – Join or Renewal – 3 points
