Grades for individual assessments (examination/coursework)

1.0 / 1.3 = very good = an excellent performance

1.7 / 2.0 / 2.3 = good = a performance which substantially exceeds the average requirements

2.7 / 3.0 / 3.3 = satisfactory = a performance corresponding to the average requirements

3.7 / 4.0 = acceptable = a performance which, in spite of its flaws, suffices to meet the requirements

5.0 = failed = a performance which does not meet the requirements due to considerable flaws.

Grading scale for the calculation of module grades in the case of several examinations or examiners.

The module grade corresponds to the grade of the module examination. If a module consists of several examinations, the calculation of the module grade is to be carried out in accordance with the respective examination regulations. Only the first decimal place is taken into consideration; all other decimal places are eliminated without rounding.

1.0 to 1.5 = very good

1.6 to 2.5 = good

2.6 to 3.5 = satisfactory

3.6 to 4.0 = acceptable

more than 4.0 = failed
