The module grade corresponds to the grade of the module examination. If a module consists of several examinations, the calculation of the module grade is to be carried out in accordance with the respective examination regulations. Only the first decimal place is taken into consideration; all other decimal places are eliminated without rounding. 1.0 to 1.5 = very good

1.6 to 2.5 = good

2.6 to 3.5 = satisfactory

3.6 to 4.0 = acceptable
