- Maintain Campus Event Calendars: Approve and coordinate student organization events, ensuring alignment with campus policies and collaboration with the Director of Event Services.
- **Support Key Institutional Events:** Assist in planning and executing large-scale programs such as Orientation, and Welcome Week to enhance student connection and retention.
- **Coordinate the Student Homecoming Experience:** Lead the planning and execution of student-focused Homecoming events, ensuring a vibrant and engaging experience that fosters school spirit, tradition, and community involvement.

- Enhance Communication & Marketing: Manage social media content and promotional efforts for the Office of Student Engagement and the broader Student Experience initiatives.
- Support Recruitment & Assessment Efforts: Assist with student recruitment events

such as Preview Day and contribute to assessment initiatives to enhance student engagement efforts.

- Serve as a Campus Leader: Participate in institutional committees and contribute to campus-wide student engagement strategies.
- Other Duties as Assigned: Support the overall mission of the Student Experience division as needed.
