Mississippi College (MC) seeks to provide a supportive environment that provides students access to their education programs when experiencing pregnancy, childbirth, or a related condition. MC can make reasonable modifications to policies, procedures and programs to assist the student. Pregnant students living in university-owned or controlled residential properties will not be involuntarily removed due to pregnancy.
